Sealed bids will be received and publicly opened and read aloud in the Administrative Offices of the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County ("PCFACC" or "Authority"), 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, New Jersey, 08110, on the following date for the following Project as follows:

Pennsauken Sanitary Landfill (PSL) E-Site Phase VI Expansion

Specifications and forms of bid have been prepared and are on file at the PCFACC offices located at 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, NJ 08110. Bid Specifications are available for download from the Camden County Division of Purchasing procurement web page. Bidders or other interested parties may obtain copies of the specifications from <http://www.camdencounty.com/government/offices-departments/division-purchasing> at no cost.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday, October 17, 2019, at the Authority's Administrative Offices at the above address. Bidders are not required, but are strongly encouraged, to attend and participate in the Pre-Bid Conference. A site walk will take place in connection with this conference.

The work which is the subject of the contract consists primarily of the construction of a Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) berm, extension of the landfill baseliner system on the inside face of the new MSE berm, and the construction of ancillary items.

In accordance with applicable law including the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq., the Authority reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid, or to reject any or all bids should the Authority deem it to be in the public interest to do so. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., N.J.A.C. 17:27 and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 10:5-33, bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c.127. The Authority welcomes and encourages minority and women-owned businesses to participate in the bidding process.

Bids must be made on the Bid Forms in the manner designated therein, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the exterior, addressed to the Executive Director, Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County, 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, NJ 08110. Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified Check, or Cashier's Check paid to the order of the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County for ten percent (10%) of the base bid, said 10% not to exceed \$20,000.00.

The signed Bid Forms and bid security must be delivered to the place named above on or before the scheduled bid opening. The successful bidder will execute the contract within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award or forfeit its bid security. Bid securities will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after award and signing of the contract.
