The existing openings shall be prepared for the installation of new Fiberglass Resin frames with Fiberglass Reinforced Polymer (FRP) doors and new hardware. The existing alarm connections and egress signage shall be removed and reinstalled. Mechanical exhaust fans shall be disconnected and reinstalled with new exterior louvers.
