

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

POLLUTION CONTROL FINANCING AUTHORITY OF CAMDEN COUNTY ANALYTICAL LABORATORY SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County (PCFACC) for Analytical Laboratory Services at the Pennsauken Sanitary Landfill.

Bids will be opened and read aloud at the PCFACC offices, 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, NJ 08110 on Friday, September 4, 2015 at 11:00 a.m., prevailing time.

The work under this contract consists of furnishing all labor, material and equipment necessary to perform certain sampling services, analytical testing, and reporting as detailed in the contract documents.

Specifications and forms of bid have been prepared by T&M Associates and are on file at the T&M Associates offices, 1256 North Church Street, Moorestown, NJ 08057, as well as the PCFACC offices located at 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, NJ 08110. Bid Specifications are available for download from the Camden County Division of Purchasing procurement web page. Bidders or other interested parties may obtain copies of the specifications from <http://www.camdencounty.com/government/offices-departments/division-purchasing> at no cost.

Bids must be made on the Bid Forms in the manner designated therein, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the exterior, addressed to the Deputy Executive Director, Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County, 9600 River Road, Pennsauken, NJ 08110. Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified Check, or Cashier's Check paid to the order of the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County for ten percent (10%) of the base bid, said 10% not to exceed \$20,000.00.

The signed Bid Forms and bid security must be delivered to the place named above on or before the scheduled bid opening. The successful bidder will execute the contract within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award or forfeit its bid security. Bid securities will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after award and signing of the contract.

Bidders are to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 *et seq.* and N.J.A.C. 17:27 Affirmative Action Regulations.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, or to make awards to such bidder or bidders who, in the judgment of the PCFACC, offers the most advantageous bid(s), and to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law. PCFACC also reserves the right to exclude individual constituents from the contract with no guarantee of any orders.
