Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Camden, New Jersey, is requesting proposals to establish pools of qualified professionals for **Architectural Services and Engineering Services for the County of Camden and its Agencies and Authorities**. Proposals must be provided to the Camden County Division of Purchasing, Courthouse - 6th Floor, 520 Market Street, Camden New Jersey, 08102. Proposals are scheduled to be opened on **Thursday, February 5th, 2026 at 10:00 A.M.** Any proposals received after said opening whether by mail or otherwise, will be returned unopened. Proposals should be provided in a sealed envelope with the title of the RFP clearly marked on the outside. If hand-delivering the proposal, it must be left in the marked bin accessible from the 6th Street entrance to the Courthouse. Bin access is Monday – Friday, 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. only. The County assumes no responsibility for delays in any form of carrier, mail, or delivery service causing the proposal to be received after the above-referenced due date and time. Submission by fax, telephone, or e-mail is **NOT PERMITTED**.

Nothing herein is intended to exclude any responsible firm or in any way restrain or restrict competition. All responsible firms are encouraged to submit proposals.

The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals submitted in the best interest of the County and the Board reserves the right to waive any defect or informality in any proposal should it be in the best interest of the County.

Proposers are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27) and N.J.S.A. 10:5-31.
