Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Camden, New Jersey, is requesting proposals for **PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO BROADWAY (CR 551), CAMDEN CITY, NJ for the Camden County Department of Public Works**. If hand-delivering, proposal must be left in the marked bin accessible from the 6th Street entrance of the Courthouse at 520 Market Street, Camden, NJ 08102. Bin access is M-F from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM only. Proposals may not be e-mailed, faxed, or transmitted over the telephone.
